DISCLOSURE OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY

Purpose:

Comply with accrediting agencies that have established as a requirement for all institutions of higher education that they have information available for students and employees on its institutional policy banning the use and disclosure of the social security.

Legal foundation:

This policy is in compliance with Law No. 186 of September 1, 2006 also known as the Act to prohibit the use of the Social Security number as a routine identification code at public and private educational institutions from elementary to graduate level.

Definition of terms:

For purpose of this policy, the Social Security number is the nine-digit number that is unique to an individual.

General Disposition:

In compliance with Act No. 186 of 2006, San Juan Bautista School of Medicine states that the institution will not show or display de Social Security number of any student and/or employee in a visible place or object, nor will the same be used as student and/or employee identification.

The School will only use student Social Security number for internal purposes such as identify verification in their application for admission, financial aid, and/or other reports required by state and/or federal law, and that are of a legitimate and official nature.

The School will only use employee Social Security number for internal purposes such as identify verification, validations, employment, taxes, or financial assistance, and that are of a legitimate and official nature.

SJBSM will not include nor issue the Social Security number of employees and/or students in directories; nor make it accessible to any person who has no need or authority for accessing said data.

In addition, the institution shall notify any employee, student, parent or guardian; under what circumstances the information will be used.

Effectiveness:

The disposition contained in this Executive Order will be effective immediately.
