



ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE (AI) POLICY

The purpose of the San Juan Bautista School of Medicine Artificial Intelligence (AI) Policy follows the school's Academic Integrity Standards and establish the Process of misconduct. This policy shall apply to all SJBSM students.

For purposes of this policy, generative AI contributions to student assignments or exams will be treated as having been contributed by a live person. Unless specifically authorized by their faculty, students:

1. May not use generative AI to substantially complete any assignment or exam; and
2. Must attribute generative AI contributions to their assignments and exams.
3. Using generative AI contrary to these requirements or others in this Policy may constitute an academic integrity violation.

Individual faculty are free to establish additional protocols regarding student use of generative AI tools in their courses, including allowing or disallowing some or all uses of such tools, provided that such protocols into their course syllabi, and clearly communicate such protocols to students. Students who are unsure of policies or protocols regarding generative AI tools are encouraged to ask their faculty for clarification and avoid any issues of misconduct.

Effectivity: The dispositions contained in this Executive Order will be effective immediately.
