RESIDENTS AS TEACHERS' POLICY

Purpose

To establish how SJBSM 'Residents as Teachers' (RAT) program prepare doctors for their role in teaching medical students. SJBSM provides training for residents to fulfill their responsibility, for each year in which they participate in teaching students.

Policy

- All incoming residents are required to attend new resident orientation, regardless of the years as residents, which includes an orientation to their roles and responsibilities as teachers. RAT orientations cover:
 - a) Role of residents as educators (teaching and assessment)
 - b) Objectives, competencies, EPA's (a copy is distributed to each Resident)
 - c) School resources to enhance teaching and assessment skills for medical students. Attendance on those opportunities is monitored by the Clinical Sciences Curriculum subcommittee.
 - d) SJBSM Non-discrimination policy
 - e) Duty hours of students and supervision policies
 - f) SJBSM Mistreatment policy
 - g) Professional conduct of students and residents.
 - h) Student evaluation on residents.
 - i) Clerkship Syllabus
- Attestation form distributed at the end of initial orientation to confirm resident participation, receipt and understanding of RAT Policy, clerkship syllabus, objectives, duty hour, supervision, professionalism, Mistreatment Policy and Nondiscriminatory Policy.

Monitoring

Residents' attendance is collected and monitored by the Clinical Science Curriculum Subcommittee. The Executive Curriculum Committee monitor annual compliance on resident's participation in the Residents as Teachers Program and revised policy as necessary to ensure that it continues to meet educational standards
