

Subject: Conversion of the Tuberculin Test

References: Occupational Safety and Health Standards (OSHA), Toxic and Hazardous Substances, Bloodborne Pathogens 1910.1030

- I. **Rule:** Every student with conversion of the tuberculin test will be referred to the Employee Clinic and to the Dean of Students.
- II. **Purpose:**
 - 1) Provide treatment and follow-up
- III. **Procedure:**
 - a) The student with the conversion case of the tuberculin test is sent to the Employee Clinic for evaluation.
 - b) The case will be notified to the Dean of Students for appropriate procedure.
 - c) The Dean of Students will notify the nurse of control of infections of the hospital to study. (follow-up)
 - d) The student can endorse his or her clerkship by order of their private physician.
 - e) The student will be given guidance to not apply again the tuberculin test and instead have a chest X-ray done for his or her health certificate.
 - f) The guidance will also include the following:
 - The meaning of a positive test
 - Importance of receiving prophylactic treatment (if required) and the risk involved if not received.
 - The importance to assist to all of the medical appointments.

IV. Effectivity

The disposition contained in this Executive Order will be effective immediately.
